Pacific Crest anticipates opening a full service Branch in early December. Pacific Crest has held a Modoc County Charter since 2002. The opening of the Alturas Branch will allow us to better serve our existing 250+ members living in Modoc County and provide valuable, convenient financial products to other residents of the community. Pacific Crest is currently in the process of hiring and training staff with the assistance of Business & Career Network Staff.

Recruitment

Modoc Business & Career Network has been working closely with the Subway/Niles on their recruitment process. Subway and the Niles were getting several applications turned in but when the company would call prospective employees to set up interviews they were getting a huge amount of no call backs or unqualified applicants; which was taking up a lot of the manager's time and making it difficult to hire good prospective employees.

To assist the business Modoc BCN put together a pre-screen process for applicants to meet with the Career Center Advisor and go through a pre-screen process to find more suitable/qualified applicants for the company. Since this system was put in place it has been very successful. Through the pre-screen we can determine what type of schedule a prospective employee is willing to work, if they will show up, and we can assist prospective employee with any questions they may have regarding the application process. This also gives Business & Career Network the opportunity to discuss services available at our office should the person like additional assistance while they are job searching.
